

Case 2

A 27-year-old Thai female, previously healthy

CC: referred due to hip fracture

PI: Three weeks PTA, she got a motorcycle accident lead to a right hip fracture with an abnormal radiologic and basic blood test results. Thus, she was referred to us.

Her past medical and personal history were unremarkable.

Her family history was also unremarkable.

Physical examination

GA: A Thai female, good consciousness

V/S: BT 36 °C BP 130/78 mmHg PR 70/min RR 16/min

HEENT: mildly pale conjunctivae, no blue sclera, normal teeth, no neck mass

CVS, RS and Abdomen: unremarkable

Neuro exam: Motor grade V all extremities, DTR 2+ all (except fracture site)

MSK: normal stature, no gross deformity, no tenderness

Skin: no hyperpigmentation
